




Enhanced efficiency and robust growth

Turnover in the first half of 2025 increased by 12.9 million euros, or 23%, compared to the first half of 2024, reaching 68.6 million euros. EBITDA increased by 4.2 million euros, reaching 16.3 million euros. EBITDA profitability percentage growth is two percentage points (in the first six months of 2025 – 24%, in the first half of 2024 – 22%). In turn, gross profit increased to 15 million euros, showing an increase of 4.1 million euros compared to the first half of 2024. In addition, the gross profitability ratio reached 22%. Investments during the reporting period totaled EUR 8 million, representing a 52% increase compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.

In the first half of 2025, CleanR Group invested in the renewal of its fleet (both in the waste management and street and road maintenance segments). Also, it continued to invest in waste container infrastructure by renewing classic containers, constructing underground container areas, and investing in textile container infrastructure. The Group continued to invest in the acquisition of specialized equipment units to increase operational efficiency.

CleanR Grupa continues regional expansion and environmental education initiatives

In the first six months of 2025, CleanR Grupa continued pursuing development and growth by enhancing its financial results and expanding regionally. The group strengthened its position in the environmental management and urban maintenance sector by investing in the infrastructural and technological updates and carrying out awareness-raising and educational initiatives about the circular economy. At the same time, the company was praised for its involvement in the capital market, and the group continued to actively engage in the pursuit of sustainability on a national level.

Waste management

By winning a tender organized by the Ogre municipality, as of February 2025, CleanR has been taking care of waste management in the rural territories of Ikšķile and Tīnuži, while as of June, following another won tender, the company has taken on servicing jointly both the towns of Ķekava and Baldone. Under the terms of the contract, CleanR will provide waste management services in these territories for the next seven years.

To diversify and expand its environmental services offer regionally, CleanR acquired 41.25% of the SIA Ķilupe shares in the reporting period. Ķilupe, a regional waste management company, has been in operation since 1988, specializing in various environmental services, including municipal waste management and handling and sorting of construction waste. Its area of operation includes Ogre and Aizkraukle

municipalities, as well as the Rīga and Pierīga region.

In the first half of 2025, the group companies continued developing by investing in the waste sorting infrastructure. In March, CleanR opened the most modern sorted waste collection site in the Baltics as part of the EU LIFE project. It is the first waste sorting site so well-equipped and automated in Rīga. At the beginning of the summer, a large-scale painting spanning about 550 square meters created by a street artist named Kiwie was also unveiled at the site. At the same time, the group company Vides pakalpojumu grupa opened a new sorted waste collection site in Liepāja. The over 900-square-meter site provides the city residents with a chance to dispose of various kinds of waste conveniently.



As part of the infrastructural improvements, CleanR expanded its underground waste container network, which considerably enhances urban aesthetics and reduces vehicle-caused emissions. At present, 87 sites

comprising 336 underground waste containers have been built.

To continue pursuing the strategic goal of reducing land-filled waste, the group company CleanR Industry, which specializes in waste recycling, has considerably grown its RDF (refuse-derived fuel) output (78% more year on year), thus strengthening its leading position in this segment, and has expanded its client range to include new export markets in the RDF segment. Also, the recycled plastic waste volumes have increased substantially, with the recycled plastic pellet output growing by 43% year on year. To further foster the reduction of landfilled waste, the company has approved investments in the plant, which will facilitate waste flow from landfilling to recovery.

In the first half of 2025, the group company Lautus continued development by expanding its range of services and improving operational processes. In the reporting period, the company acquired new vacuum-pumping machinery, which has allowed the company to boost its capacity and flexibility in servicing customers. Also, the company has started offering a new service—internal sewerage system maintenance, which expands its options in the area of engineering communications.

In the medical waste management segment, significant technical and procedural improvements were made, which have helped the company to meet its customers' demands more effectively. The company's professional capabilities have been recognized by awarded

public procurements, which, from now on, include servicing the Emergency Medical Service and Riga 1st Hospital.



CleanR Verso, an industrial and construction and demolition waste management company, updated its vehicle fleet by purchasing several specialized vehicles to transport construction and demolition waste containers and increase operational efficiency of the building refuse sorting and recycling center.

The group's extended responsibility system provider Zaļā josta introduced a new service in the first half of 2025—management of the waste items containing plastic. Also, by addressing the current trends in the electricity production and storage market, in addition to handling solar panels, the company offers management of power banks. As of 2025, Zaļā josta has fully developed and introduced a new, modern data accounting system as well as a customer reporting platform, which improves the precision and completeness of the gathered data.

Urban maintenance

In July this year, we finalized the SIA Tranzīts L acquisition deal initiated last The Competition Council greenlighted the agree- ment by allowing the group's urban services company, Vizii Urban, to acquire a majority interest in the firm. These investments are aimed at fostering Vizii Urban's growth in Latvia's municipalities and ensuring the transfer of urban maintenance expertise, thus increasing the quality of the services.

Vizii Urban also invested in vehicle fleet updates, expanding its technical capabilities to include 13 new specialized trucks as well as three EURO VI specialized vehicles equipped with machinery for winter works and vacuum pumps for street cleaning in the summer.

At the same time, Vizii Urban has won a contract to look after the Jūrmala beaches and places for swimming in Riga in the spring-autumn season.

In the field of urban services, KOM-AUTO, Vizii Urban's subsidiary, continued strengthening its position by winning several procurements in the first half of the year for road maintenance in the spring-summer season, ensuring dust removal in Valmiera, Rēzekne, and Burtnieki municipality, as well as in the territories of the Līgatne and Amata Association in Cesis municipality, including gravel road works in the territory of Līgatne Association in Cēsis municipality.

In the commercial cleaning segment, the group company Vizii continued to pursue innovation by increasing its number of cleaning robots to 70 units. These units ensure high cleaning and hygiene standards by adapting to the specific needs of various sites and enhancing service quality.



Corporate governance

In May, CleanR Grupa increased its share capital by issuing new shares to participants of the company's employee stock option plan, thereby expanding the Group's shareholder base to include senior executives enrolled in the personnel option scheme established last year.

At the same time, CleanR Grupa continued promoting environmental education and a circular lifestyle in society by setting up Šūna, an environmental education concept space, in Cēsis—Latvia's capital of culture—from May to the end of July. The space offered several practical and educational activities devoted to the environment, climate, and circularity. Also, to raise awareness of a sustainable lifestyle and proper waste sorting, CleanR, together with Zaļā josta, created the digital environmental education platform videspratiba.lv. The site hosts practical information on waste sorting,

the circular economy, and environmental issues, offering a reliable point of contact for those wishing to make environmentally friendly decisions.

CleanR Grupa also continued participating in the Junior Achievement Latvia Leadership program, where young people were tasked with generating creative ideas that would promote environmental awareness and sustainability. They will have a chance to develop solutions that would foster people's understanding of the circular economy, a sustainable lifestyle, waste sorting habits, and environmental protection.



In February 2025, CleanR Grupa won the Best Investor Relations award of the Nasdaq Baltic Awards 2025 in the First North bond market.

Finally, CleanR Grupa's Chairman of the Council, Guntars Kokorevičs, was repeatedly elected as a member of the Employer's Confederation of Latvia (LDDK) Council. Kokorevičs will continue working on the LDDK Council for the next three years, working to strengthen the business environment and defending employers' interests.

Currently, we at "CleanR Grupa" have begun preparatory work and plan to implement bond refinancing, with more details to follow.


